Number and Length of Sessions

- Web-based conferencing service for visual presentations during sessions
- Online hosting service for group discussions and postings between sessions

Quality of Participation

Your commitment to the following is indicated by your registration.

- Show up on time for each of the 10 tele-classes with your full presence: head, heart, and hands
- Engage the assignments between each session with full commitment: do your own reflecting and posting, and respond to the postings provided by other participants and by the facilitator(s)
- Take full responsibility if you must miss a class: discuss your absence with the facilitator(s) in advance, and work with your cohort members to get the information you missed

Preparing for the Tele-Class

- Ensure your access to a telephone and high-speed internet
- Establish your online profile within the hosting system being used by your class
- Post a 1-2 page biography describing who you are: where you live, where you're from, what your work is about, what your interests are
- Post a 1-2 paragraph discussion of why you are taking this tele-class
- Read postings submitted by other tele-class participants as they register
- Read *Making a World of Difference. Personal Leadership: A Methodology of Two Principles and Six Practices* (2008), by Schaetti, Ramsey, and Watanabe. FlyingKite, Seattle
- Reflect upon your reading of the book and post 3 core insights and 3 core questions
